Monica C. LoCascio is a transdisciplinary artist focusing on materiality. Her works arrive as artifacts of her material and theoretical research on memory, somatics, fermentation, epigenetics, heritage crafts, and hierarchies of knowledge and power. She pairs fermented bio-materials, salvaged fiber, and heritage craft techniques with industrial and salvaged materials to examine the tension between the fluidity and vulnerability of the lived human experience and the systems and institutions that are designed to control it. She began her art-making practice at the age of 5 when she was taught to crochet and embroider by her grandfather's twin sister. She lives and works in Vienna, Austria.
